

Kingsbrook Meadows: An Introduction

Welcome

This exhibition is to introduce you to Kingsbrook Meadows, which will be a wonderful new place for you to visit, right on your doorstep.

The idea is to create a place where you can come to enjoy a great time in nature, with all the benefits that being in wild places can bring.

It is part of Barratt David Wilson's (BDW) Kingsbrook development and is due to be created by BDW and the RSPB, and then managed by the RSPB in perpetuity.

Outline planning was granted back in 2011 as part of the overall Kingsbrook development. Subject to planning permission, its creation should commence in 2023, with it likely to be open to the public in 2024/25.

It is expected the detailed planning application will be submitted in autumn 2022, so now seemed a perfect time to start to share the ideas with local people.

Kingsbrook Meadows will be a wonderful complement to Kingsbrook, where so much effort is being made to raise the national bar for wildlife-friendly new housing.

Where will Kingsbrook Meadows be?

Kingsbrook Meadows is a large area of open countryside directly east of Kingsbrook and Bierton, on the opposite side of Mike Griffin Way (the Eastern Link Road) as shown.
