It will incorporate:

- Excellent pedestrian and cycle access, plus a car park with charging points
- A visitor centre to start your visit, with a large café looking towards the Chilterns
- Accessible toilets, including a Changing Places toilet for those with severely restricted mobility
- An extensive network of paths to explore, many fit for disability buggies.
- Areas suitable for dogs
- Demonstration wildlife-friendly gardens to inspire you
- A wild play area on a grand scale, a landscape of grassy mounds and trees, to let imaginations run wild with nature all around
- Plenty of opportunities for a quiet time in nature and a spot of birdwatching
- In summer, we'll have fields full of flowers, great for the bees and then providing birds with seed in winter
- An extensive events programme and the chance to hire the large café space
- Maybe you'd even like to come and work here!

Inclusivity and diversity will be at the heart of what we do. We expect the Meadows will be open every day except Christmas Day.
